- 2) Add your event to the Nearby Events list, so other riders in your area can see it and learn more about your club.
- 3) See events listed near or far by other snowmobile and ATV clubs.
- 4) Use the new "Collections" feature to group your tracks, waypoints and planned rides, and share it all as a collection with others.

Minnesota United Snowmobile Association (MnUSA) Uses Ride Command To Track 10 Groups During Veterans Appreciation Ride

On January 11, 2020, 150 snowmobilers gathered in Two Harbors, Minnesota, for the 12th Annual Veterans Appreciation Ride. After a hearty breakfast, everyone geared up, broke into 10 groups, and enjoyed a ride on scenic, groomed trails along the North Shore of Lake Superior. MnUSA board members monitored the groups using the Ride Command Group Ride feature. That allowed them to see if any group had to stop along the pre-planned route for any reason, providing their exact location in case they needed assistance. “For a group ride of this size, it really helped us a lot,” said Jerry Hanson with MnUSA. “It worked perfectly.”
